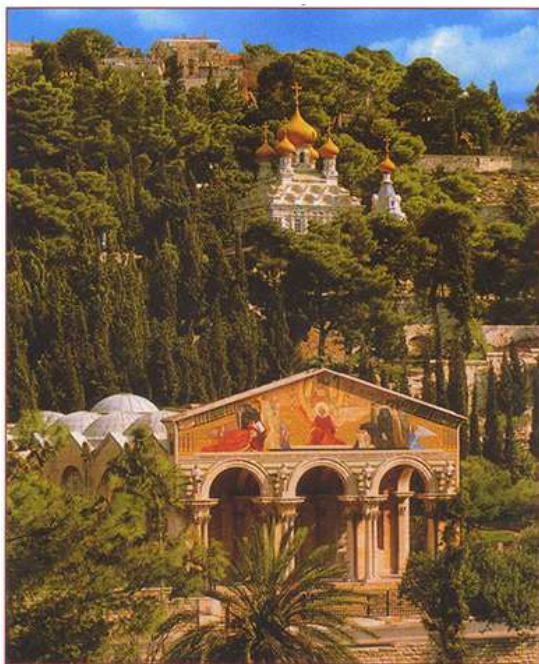

ITINERARY



1st Day

Depart Wichita airport for our trans-Atlantic flight to Tel-Aviv. Group will meet at the airport three hours prior to departure.

2nd Day

Arrive at Tel-Aviv (TLV) airport. We will be met and assisted at the airport and transferred to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight (D/O).

3rd Day

Today we take a walking tour of Old Jerusalem starting through Via Dolorosa visiting on the way St. Anne's Church, Lithostratos and Pilate's Judgment Hall and continuing through the various stations of the cross all way to the Holy Sepulcher Church. In the afternoon, we walk through the picturesque native bazaars of the Old City as we make our exit outside the Wall to return to our hotel for D/O.

4th Day

We begin our tour this morning at the Mount of Olives. We visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster, Dominus Flevit and walk along Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations, which stands on the Rock of the Agony. From there we view the Eastern (Golden) Gate and the Pinnacle of the Temple. We continue our drive through the Kedron Valley to Mount Zion for a visit to the Wailing Wall and will make a stop at St. Peter's Church in Gallicantu to visit the House of Caiaphas "the High Priest", and the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned the night He was arrested. We proceed for a stop at the Room of the Last Supper and the Tomb of David before we continue our drive to Bethlehem, the birth-place of Jesus. There we visit the Church of Nativity and make a stop in Bethlehem for shopping on our return to Jerusalem for D/O.

5th Day

Morning service before we drive north up the coastal highway to the ancient port of Caesarea, built by King Herod the Great. On to Megiddo and Haifa to see Mount Carmel and to visit Elijah's Cave. View the beautiful Gardens of the Bahai Temple and continue through the Valley of Armageddon to visit the Church of Annunciation in Nazareth. We continue our drive through Cana to Tiberius for D/O.

6th Day

We start our day by taking an inspiring boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We then board our bus to visit Capernaum, Jesus' second home. See the 2nd century synagogue and the House of Peter's mother-in-law. We drive to Tabgha, the chapel dedicated to the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes. Visit the Mount of Beatitudes, the site of the Sermon on the Mount. On to River Jordan and drive down the Jordan Valley to Jericho for D/O.

7th Day

This morning we visit Jericho, the world's oldest city, view the Mt. of Temptation and continue to visit Qumran where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. We then drive by the Dead Sea, the lowest point on Earth, to Massada where the Jewish Zealots held out against the advancing Roman Legions. On the way back we stop at Ein Gedi and take a dip in the Dead Sea and then drive up the Judean mountains to Jerusalem for D/O.

8th Day

Communion Service at the Garden Tomb. Free rest of the day.

9th Day

Morning transfer to TLV airport for our flight back to the US.
