

IN-PERSON WORSHIP Scheduled for the Fourth Sunday in Lent

Dear Parishioners,

With Sedgwick County's COVID-19 numbers on the decrease and three weeks of the county being in the "yellow" zone, **we have the go-ahead to worship in person for the Fourth Sunday in Lent at 10:45 a.m. this Sunday, March 14.**

A few guidelines:

- + All present must wear masks.
- + Temperatures will be taken.
- + Name tags will **not** be worn.
- + The service will be intentionally short.
- + Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance to the church, in the bride's room (the north narthex of the nave), and in the workroom as you near the exit. If you need hand sanitizer while you are at your seat, please notify an usher.
- + The People will be seated with the assistance of ushers in appropriately distanced locations in the church. Individuals living in the same household may sit together. Overflow will be in the Guild Hall.
- + To discourage the spread of COVID-19, restroom use is strongly discouraged; physical touch is not permitted; and the use of Books of Common Prayer and Hymnals is temporarily discontinued.
- + To protect one another from the spread of disease, we will not sing together as a congregation.
- + If you don't feel well, please stay at home and worship online.


We will record Sunday's service, and it will be available on our [YouTube](#) channel later Sunday for those who can't or prefer not to worship in person.
